Parks and Recreation Summer Program Registration

Health Department Reminds Homeowners to Test their Water

Is your home served by a private well? Take the opportunity to test your water quality during National Groundwater Awareness Week occurring March 8-14. Water quality can change over time, so it is important to test your well water every few years. Spring is a good time of year to test your water with a full potability test to look for important constituents such as bacteria, nitrate/nitrite, pH and uranium. Homeowners Tax Credit Program

The application period for the Homeowners Tax Credit Program runs from February 1-May 15, 2026. This is an income-based program available to homeowners who turned 65 on or before 12/31/25. Current recipients due to reapply were notified by mail.

Business Personal Property Declarations

Business owners who have not filed the 2025 Declaration of Personal Property which was due on November 1, 2025 have until March 31, 2026 to submit a late filing and avoid an estimated assessment. Late filing penalty will apply.

Farm Abatement Applications

The Town Council may abate up to 50% of the property taxes for certain types of farms. To qualify for an abatement an annual application must be submitted to the Assessor's Office between April 1st and May 15th. Farms that are currently receiving an abatement will be notified by mail of the requirement to reapply.

May 11, 2026, is the deadline to transfer from one Party to another and be eligible to vote in the state and district office primary of the new party. If either the Democratic or Republican Party has a Primary, it will be held on August 11, 2026. Early Voting will be available from August 3 to August 9, 2026.
